

RESOLUTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE VICE-RECTORATE FOR INNOVATION AND TRANSFER OF THE UNIVERSITAT DE VALÈNCIA APPROVING THE REGULATORY BASES AND CALL FOR THE TOXICOIL PRIZES, AIMED AT BACHELOR'S, MASTER'S DEGREE STUDENTS AND DOCTORAL STUDENTS FROM UNIVERSITAT DE VALÈNCIA, THE UNIVERSITÉ DE BOURGOGNE EUROPE- Institut Agro-Dijon (FRANCE) AND THE UNIVERSITÀ DEGLI STUDI DI PALERMO (ITALY), FOR THE 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR, WITH THE PATRONAGE OF SANTANDER UNIVERSITIES AND WITHIN FRAMEWORK OF THE INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMME OF EDUCATIONAL INNOVATION IN UNIVERSITY ENTREPRENEURSHIP

UVemprén is the proposal by the Office of the Vice-Rector for Innovation and Transfer of the Universitat de València (UV) to help build a university that is committed to the professional development of students and to the progress of society.

To achieve this goal, the institution has launched a master plan that seeks to establish an entrepreneurial campus model that offers students complementary training pathways that allow them to accredit skills and opt for entrepreneurship voluntarily while developing their careers, and thus build a personal and professional life project.

One of UVemprén's lines of action is to promote the design and execution of educational innovation projects in university entrepreneurship among the UV's teaching and research staff through the annual call for grants of the UVemprén-Aprèn International Programme. Participation in this programme also involves attending a training programme in entrepreneurship at an international centre of recognised prestige. These actions, launched under the patronage of Campus Santander Open Academy, produce returns to university students in terms of entrepreneurship, thanks to the educational innovation projects that the teaching and research staff implement after their stay.

In this context, the Office of the Vice-Rector for Innovation and Transfer offers to call for the **ToxiCOIL** prizes aimed at bachelor's, master's degree and doctoral students from three institutions (Universitat de València, Université de Bourgogne Europe- Institut Agro-Dijon and Università degli studi di Palermo) with the aim of providing participants with the opportunity to develop intercultural skills, work in international teams, improve technological learning skills, provide the opportunity to students participating in this programme to acquire international training in toxicology to generate challenges that may have a business or entrepreneurial output, that are innovative and allow projecting Food Safety solutions from toxicology and health sciences areas, acquire new experiences and establish contacts through their participation in specific training activities in entrepreneurial skills.

This programme aims to become an effective instrument to promote creativity and entrepreneurial culture among our students and to introduce participants into the entrepreneurial ecosystem of Universitat de València so that they can continue developing their entrepreneurial project and opt for entrepreneurship as one more professional option in parallel to their studies.

In the framework of this initiative, the Office of the Vice-Rector for Innovation and Transfer, using the powers conferred on it by Resolution of 20 May 2022, of the Rector of the Universitat de València (DOGV – Official Journal of the Government of Valencia, of 30 May 2022), by which certain competences are delegated to vice-rectors, the general secretary, the general manager and other bodies of this university,

RESOLVES

First

To call for the **ToxiCOIL** prizes of Universitat de València within the framework of the Campus UVemprén - Santander Open Academy, and to approve the regulatory bases governing this call, which are included as Annex I to this resolution.

This call is aimed at bachelor's, master's degree and doctoral students from Universitat de València, Université de Bourgogne Europe- Institut Agro-Dijon and Università degli studi di Palermo, enrolles in the 2024-2025 academic year, and consists of the granting of:

- A maximum of €700 distributed as follows:
 - two runner-up prizes of € 150,
 - a first prize of € 400 for the most outstanding projects.

Second

Universitat de València will contribute to the financing of this programme with:

- Up to a maximum of € 700 harged to chapter IV of the economic classification of expenditure, organic **2100352451** and specific **20230136** of the budget for the 2025 financial year of Universitat de València, intended to cover the **ToxiCOIL** awards provided for in this call.

Third

An appeal for reconsideration may be filed against this resolution, which exhausts the administrative route, within one month from the day after its publication, before the same body that issued the resolution, or an administrative litigation appeal may be filed before the bodies of the contentious-administrative jurisdiction of the Valencian Community within two months from the day after its publication.

ANNEX I

REGULATORY BASES AND CALL FOR THE TOXICOIL PRIZES, AIMED AT BACHELOR'S, MASTER'S DEGREE STUDENTS AND DOCTORAL STUDENTS FROM UNIVERSITAT DE VALÈNCIA, THE UNIVERSITÉ DE BOURGOGNE EUROPE- Institut Agro-Dijon (FRANCE) AND THE UNIVERSITÀ DEGLI STUDI DI PALERMO (ITALY), FOR THE 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR.

1. Aim

These regulatory bases govern the implementation of the **ToxiCOIL** programme through the call for 30 places to select students enrolled in the 2024-2025 academic year in Universitat de València, Université de Bourgogne Europe- Institut Agro-Dijon and the Università degli studi di Palermo.

The call consists of the granting of:

- A maximum of €700 distributed as follows:
 - o two runner-up prizes of € 150,
 - o a first prize of € 400 for the most outstanding projects.

Universitat de València will contribute to the financing of this programme with up to a maximum of € 700 charged to chapter IV of the economic classification of expenditure, organic **2100352451** and specific **20230136** of the budget for the 2025 financial year of Universitat de València, intended to cover the **ToxiCOIL** awards provided for in this call.

The participants will work as a multicenter team to generate a challenge within an innovative project focused on food safety, toxicology, environment or nutrition. Upon completion of their challenges/projects, they must submit their projects to be evaluated by a committee. All participants whose projects are considered **SUITABLE** will receive a certificate of achievement. In addition, the teams will compete against each other for two runner-up prizes of €150, and a first prize of € 400.

2. Beneficiaries, requirements and applications

This call is open to bachelor's, master's degree and doctoral students enrolled in the 2024-2025 academic year in any of the following three institutions:

- Universitat de València
- Université de Bourgogne Europe- Institut Agro-Dijon
- Università degli studi di Palermo

2.1. Formalización de solicitudes

Applications must be submitted using a standard application form: (<https://webges.uv.es/uvEntreuWeb/?idioma=en#/login?idform=EXPSOLP2U&idgrupo>) addressed to the Entrepreneurship Unit (Unitat d'Emprenedoria-UVemprén), through the **"Premis ToxiCOIL 2025"** procedure and must provide the following documentation:

- Supporting documents evidencing the level of English.

Applications must be submitted through the electronic registry of Universitat de València.

The following steps must be followed:

3. 3. In the "General" tab, select:

 - b. Body to which it is addressed: Unitat d'Emprenedoria (**UVEMPRÉN**)
 - c. Select "Gestions específiques de la unitat" and in the drop-down menu, choose **PREMIOS ToxiCOIL 2025**
 - d. In the "Fitxers adjunts" tab, click on "Arxiu" and attach Annex II, which must have previously been completed and signed. You must also upload the documents evidencing the level of English.

In the case of students enrolled in higher education centres outside the Universitat de València:

1. Complete Annex II: Application form (Annex II)
2. Request access to the electronic register of the Universitat de València:

3. Display the "Headquarters User" menu and request access. This procedure allows you to request a username and password to access the Electronic Office of the Universitat de València. Once you have filled in all the fields, you must press the send button. The Universitat de València will send you an email to the email address you have indicated.
4. In the "General" tab, choose:
 - a. Type of Unit: University, general and central services.
 - b. Body to which it is addressed: Entrepreneurship Unit (UVEMPRÉN)
 - c. Select "Specific procedures of the unit" and in the drop-down menu, choose **PREMIOS ToxiCOIL 2025**
 - d. In the "Attached files" tab, under Select file: Annex II must be previously completed and signed. Likewise, documentation accrediting the level of English must be attached

Applications that do not meet the requirements set out in these bases, include false data, are not submitted in accordance with the specified requirements or are not accompanied by all the documents required will be excluded from the selection process.

Submission of the application implies full acceptance of the contest regulatory bases.

2.2. Deadline

The period for submitting applications will begin on the day after the publication of the extract of this call in the Official Journal of the Government of Valencia (DOGV) and will end on 1 april 2025 at 23:59 p.m. (CEST time zone).

The publication will be announced on the UV Notice Board (<https://webges.uv.es/uvTaeWeb/>) and on UVemprén website (<https://www.uv.es/uvempren>).

Once the applications have been reviewed, the Steering Committee will publish the provisional list of admitted and excluded applicants. If the applications are incomplete, applicants will be notified so that they can correct them within a period of ten days, after which the Steering Committee will publish the final resolution.

If application exceed the number of places available, the procedure and criteria established in section 4.1 of these regulatory bases shall apply.

The provisional resolution and the final resolution will be published on the UV Notice Board (<https://webges.uv.es/uvTaeWeb/>) for notification purposes and, additionally, on UVemprén website (<https://www.uv.es/uvempren>) for information purposes only.

3 Steering Committee and selection and evaluation committees.

3.1. Steering Committee

The Steering Committee for this call is the Entrepreneurship Unit of Universitat de València (UVemprén).

3.2 Candidate Selection Committee

Candidates will be selected by a committee made up of the following members:

- The director of the Entrepreneurship Unit of the University of Valencia (UVemprén) or the person delegated for that purpose, who shall chair the Committee.
- Two specialists of the Entrepreneurship Unit of the University of Valencia (UVemprén), one of whom will act as secretary of the Committee at the proposal of the president of the Project Evaluation Committee.

3.3. Project Evaluation Committee

The projects submitted will be evaluated by an Evaluation Committee made up of the following members:

- The director of the Entrepreneurship Unit of the University of Valencia (UVemprén) or the

person delegated for that purpose, who shall chair the Committee.

- A specialist of the Entrepreneurship Unit of the University of Valencia (UVemprén) who shall act as secretary of the Committee and who shall take part but not vote
- 1 lecturer in entrepreneurship from Universitat de València appointed by the vice-rector for Innovation and Transfer.
- 1 representative from Université de Bourgogne Europe- Institut Agro-Dijon.
- 1 representative from Università degli studi di Palermo.

4. Selection process and evaluation criteria

4.1. Process and criteria for selecting candidates and forming teams

The selection of candidates will be carried out by the Candidate Selection Committee provided for in section 3.2 of these regulatory bases according to the following criteria:

- **Course enrolled:** preference is given to applicants enrolled in more advanced courses. Applications from doctoral students will be given 40 points; master's degree will be given 30 points, fourth-year bachelor's degree students will be given 20 points; third-year students will be given 10 points; second-year students will be given 5 points, and first-year students will be given 0 points.
- **Level of English:** applications from holders of a C2 or C1 English certificate will be given 40 points; holders of a B2 English certificate will be given 30 points, and holders of a B1 English certificate will be given 20 points.
- The order of registration will be valued: 20 points:

After selecting the candidates, the Selection Committee will form the teams that will carry out the innovative business project together with an academic tutor. The teams will have between 3 and 6 members, with a minimum of 1 candidate and a maximum of 2 candidates from each of the three institutions. The tutor must be from one of the three institutions

The tutor will be from one of the three institutions. The persons admitted to the **ToxiCOIL** programme and the teams formed will be published on 3 April 2025.

4.2. Process and criteria for selecting winning teams.

The evaluation of the final projects submitted by the teams will be carried out by the Project Evaluation Committee provided for in section 3.3 of these regulatory bases.

Upon completion of the **ToxiCOIL** training programme, the teams must submit three documents which will be evaluated by the Project Evaluation Committee: a project summary sheet, an executive summary of their business idea and an infographic of strategies for revaluation of by-products, included in the SDGs of the 2030 Agenda. Students will be provided with the specific documents that they must fill out

during the course for the preparation of the summary sheet and the executive summary.

Among the projects rated as SUITABLE, 3 will be selected to compete for the two runner-up prizes of €150, and a first prize of € 400. These 3 projects will have to be presented in a closing session, in no more than 10 minutes, in which the teams must defend the feasibility of their projects before the Evaluation Committee. The projects submitted will be evaluated by the Committee referred to in section 3.3 according to the criteria below with a maximum of 100 points. A minimum score of 50 points is required for the project to be rated as SUITABLE, as long as at least 80% of the training has been successfully completed.

Projects will be assessed according to the following criteria:

- Description of the idea and its value proposal (maximum score: 20 points).
- Description of the process or problem to be solved, need and opportunity (maximum score: 20 points).
- Degree of innovation and creativity (maximum score: 20 points).
- Ability to identify the resources needed to start the project (maximum score: 20 points).
- Infographics (maximum score: 20 points).

The procedure for granting the prizes will be carried out on a competitive basis, in accordance with the provisions of article 22 of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on Subsidies, and according to the criteria established in this section.

5. Resolution.

The award procedure shall be competitive.

The Project Evaluation Committee, through the Steering Committee of this call and based on the assessment report, will submit a motivated proposal for granting the prizes to the Office of the Vice-Rector for Innovation and Transfer, and allow a period of ten days for the submission of observations, which will issue a final resolution on beneficiaries and non-beneficiaries with their corresponding score. The winning applications, on the basis of the minutes of the Evaluation Commission, will be announced on 16 April at the closing ceremony of the programme.

The resolution will be published on the UV Notice Board (<https://webges.uv.es/uvtaeweb>) for the purpose of notification and, additionally, on the UVemprén website (<https://www.uv.es/uvempren>) for information purposes.

The concession resolution must be effective within a maximum period of six months from the publication of the call, as established in Article 25 of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on Subsidies.

Against the final resolution on beneficiaries, which exhausts the administrative route, an appeal for review may be filed within one month from the day following its publication, before the same body that issued the

resolution, or an administrative litigation appeal before the organs of the administrative litigation jurisdiction of the Valencian Community within two months from the day following its publication.

6. Payment of prizes

The payment of the amount of the prizes awarded to the winning teams will be processed once the resolution has been made public on the UV Notice Board.

The final decision on the winners of the competition will be communicated to the prize-winners so that, within ten days from the day following receipt of the notification, they may expressly accept the prize..

The amount will be shared equally among all team members and will be paid into the bank account opened in the name of each participant.

The prize is subject to the corresponding withholding tax established in the regulations in force.

Should a prize winner decline the monetary prize awarded, the total amount will be distributed among the other members of the winning team. Declinations must be submitted in writing.

7. Compatibility

These prizes are compatible with any other type of public or private aid, as long as the total amount received does not exceed the total cost of the activity for which the prize is awarded.

8. Intellectual property

Those who participate in this call guarantee that they are owners of the property rights of the contents presented.

9. Applicable law

For any matters not provided for herein, the call must be interpreted in accordance with the legislation applicable to aid and other ex gratia cash contributions made by entities of the public sector of the Valencian Community, namely, Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on Subsidies, Law 1/2015 of the Generalitat, of Public Finance, of the Instrumental Public Sector and of Subsidies, and Law 39/2015, of 1 October, of the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administration.

- To the Spanish subsidies database (BDNS), in compliance with the provisions of Article 20 of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on Subsidies.

programme, the data will be kept for the entire period linked to the management of the call, will be incorporated, if appropriate, into the student's academic record and will be kept for purposes of accreditation and certification of the award and any other related academic merit.

10.6.Rights
