First. General requirements of applicants

- 1.1. Candidates should have Spanish nationality or have the nationality of a country member or be of any of the states in which, by virtue of international treaties established by the European Union and ratified by Spain, the free movement of workers is applicable, in the terms in which said legislation is defined in the founding Treaty of the European Union, in this case they must present the receipt of have applied for the community residence card.
