**Indications for incoming exchange students from partner universities who are attending the University of Valencia next academic year 2020/2021.
(this information may change according to the ongoing circumstances)**

Though the pandemic has caused unprecedented disruption to learning and teaching at universities worldwide, we are focused now on the new academic year 2020/2021 and what this will look like for exchange students.

Our plans for the upcoming academic year **starting September 14** rest on the principles of protecting the health and wellbeing of the student and staff community together with the delivery of the highest quality education possible for all the students.

In consonance with our Government and Ministry of Health indications, it is clear that bringing large groups of students together for lectures will not be possible. Consequently, the University of Valencia will be offering a **blended course scheme** during Semester 1, combining programmes online with face-to-face on-campus (laboratory classes, practical sessions in small groups), only where possible and permitted, in line with social distancing protocols. Please, be well aware that **courses will not be exclusively offered online** and that you are not allowed to follow the online programme from your home institution.

On a positive note, we are working on the assumption that a more confident scenario will predominate the following months which will allow the delivery of face-to-face teaching and learning in Semester 2.

We are working hard now to ensure that your stay in Valencia is the safest and best possible we can provide, whatever the circumstances.
