### SUMMARY

Business and Economic History (BEH) is a module of the *Grado de Administración y Dirección de Empresas* (GADE) and the *Grado de Finanzas y Contabilidad* (GFYC). This course is taught in the second semester of the first year. It is aimed at examining the evolution and transformation of the world economy, and business organisations. To the prospective students of the *Grado de Administración y Dirección de Empresas* (GADE), *Grado de Economía* (GECO) and the *Grado de Finanzas y Contabilidad* (GFYC), the Business and Economic History course offers the possibility of exploring the world economy in the long run, and learning how the changing economic circumstances (technological and institutional change, consumption patterns, financial crises) have affected the ownership, industrial organisation and management of business organisations.
