This Agreement is entered into by and between the Universidad de Valencia, Unidad de Genómica Comparativa (UV-CGU) whose address is Calle Doctor Moliner, 50; Burjassot 46100 (Valencia) Spain and the organization or individual identified herein ("Licensee") and shall be effective as of the date of acceptance by UV-CGU.

INTRODUCTION:

I. UV-CGU has developed software that it wishes to make available on a nonexclusive basis to interested parties for noncommercial internal research purposes only.

II. Licensee seeks to obtain a nonexclusive license to software developed by UV-CGU for use by Licensee for noncommercial internal research purposes only.

III. Licensee is an authorized representative capable of legally binding an academic institution, government agency or nonprofit institution. Students and non-permanent employees must have an authorized official sign this Agreement. Postdocs can sign in this agreement.

TERMS:

In consideration of the promises contained in this Agreement, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Licensee and UV-CGU agree as follows:

1. The software subject to the terms of this Agreement is entitled UVCLUSTER ("UV-CGU Software").
2. UV-CGU hereby grants to Licensee a nonexclusive, non-transferable, royalty-free site license to use the UV-CGU Software, which license shall become effective after acceptance of this Agreement by UV-CGU and upon transfer of the program to Licensee by UV-CGU. Licensee may make backup copies of the UV-CGU Software for archival or disaster recovery purposes. As soon as practicable, and no later than 5 business days after the execution of this Agreement, UV-CGU shall send a working copy of the software to Licensee via the email address set forth herein. The license shall be valid only for the site listed as Licensee's address.
3. This Agreement and the license granted herein are not assignable by Licensee without the prior written approval of an authorized official of UV-CGU. UV-CGU Software may not be transferred or distributed to any other party by Licensee without the prior written approval of an authorized official of UV-CGU.
4. Title, ownership rights, and intellectual property rights in and to UV-CGU Software shall remain in UV-CGU or its suppliers, subject to the license granted herein. UV-CGU Software is protected by copyright laws of Spain, and under international treaties.
5. Licensee agrees to keep all copyright, proprietary and confidentiality notices affixed to the software (including any back-up copy). No modifications of the UV-CGU Software by the Licensee are allowed.
6. Licensee acknowledges that UV-CGU Software is experimental. **UV-CGU Software IS PROVIDED "AS IS," AND UV-CGU MAKES NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR NONINFRINGEMENT.**

Neither party shall be liable for any claim, demand or action for any loss, harm, illness or other damage or injury arising from access to or use of UV-CGU Software or associated information, including without limitation any direct, indirect, incidental, exemplary, special or consequential damages, even if advised of the possibility of such damage. In no event shall either party's liability under this Agreement from any cause exceed the amount of license fees, if any, received by UV-CGU from Licensee hereunder.

8. Each party is acting as an independent contractor and not as an agent, partner, or joint venturer with the other party for any purpose. No supplement, modification or amendment of this Agreement shall be binding, unless in writing signed by a duly authorized representative of each party to the Agreement.
