Deadline housing Application

Application forms for housing received before 1 April will be taken into the procedure. Please take into consideration the time it takes your application to reach our offices. *Forms reaching our offices later than 1 April will be processed upon availability.*

The deadline for the spring semester is 15 October.

Housing procedure

All requests for housing will be labelled in the order they arrive in at our offices. As housing capacity is limited, applicants will be offered housing on a first come basis. At the end of May or the beginning of June you will receive notice at the address you indicated above whether you will be offered housing.

Fees

- Once accepted to the programme, students are obliged to pay a € 500,- non-refundable deposit within four weeks of acceptance. This counts towards the tuition fee and confirms the student's participation in the programme. *This deposit does not apply to exchange students.*
