OPEN ISSUES

This section summarizes known problems that have not been resolved for this release.

- If you define a target link with a label that is a subset of the label in another target link, you may experience unexpected results when activating the former link; a search for an endpoint with the shorter label may open a record at the location of an endpoint with the longer label. *CR00006582*
- In some environments, the mapping of network disk drives may confuse PL's installation program. If you experience difficulty installing PL over a network, you should install to a local drive and copy the files to the desired network location. *CR00006252*
- If your database's source files contain lines that are longer than 256 characters, highlighting of hit words may not always be accurate. This is only a highlighting issue; line length does not affect search accuracy. *CR00006824*
- PL-Admin's accelerator keystrokes will not work if the PL-Admin main window is not active. You can make the main window active by clicking on its menu bar, at which point the accelerator keystrokes will become available. *CR00006907*
- When defining fields, you may enter field names of up to 29 characters. While the field name entry dialog allows you to enter more than this maximum, any characters beyond the limit will be discarded. *CR00007029*
- If you set record display preferences so that record windows open at the location of the first hit word, this setting will not apply to record windows that are already open. *CR00007109*

DOCUMENTATION ISSUES

- The DOS batch administration utilities, documented in the Advanced Topics appendix in the User's Guide, are not included in the standard Personal Librarian package. If you want to acquire these utilities, contact your sales representative.
